

Manure Management Plan Requirements:

- Every farm in PA that land applies on-farm or imported manure must have and implement a Manure Management Plan.
- A Manure Management Plan can be prepared by the farmer or by another trained individual.
- The format and worksheets from the Manure Management Manual must be followed unless approved by DEP.
- The Manure Management Plans do not need to be submitted for approval but must be available to DEP or Conservation District Staff on request of inspection.
- Records of manure management plan implementation must be kept on the farm.



Come prepared to fill out your farm's Manure Management Plan. We will be providing the DEP's current Land Application of Manure Manual as well as all forms necessary to stay compliant with Pennsylvania's current regulations.

We will be spending most of day filling out the forms and you should leave the workshop with a completed Manure Management Plan for your farm.

During this day long workshop, you will be able to complete a Manure Management Plan for your operation with the help of District Staff.

This will be a very informal workshop. The format for this workshop is to combine short lectures with actual hands-on completion of the DEP provided worksheets.

Registration will be from **8:30 to 9am** and the workshop will start at 9am. We should conclude the workshop sometime between 2:30 and 3pm.
